

A: "Yes, we had a dedication. The commissioner came down. And Mr. Babcock spoke, I have a brother, him and my mother attended along with me."

#### Q: How do you feel about it being named after him?

A: "I think that it is a great honor."

#### Q: What do you remember about vour dad?

A: "He died when I was 26, of a heart attack, May 10, 1976."
