"My brother is the biggest inspiration in my life," said Kunkler.

Kunkler trains at Sam Vernon's Martial Arts and Fitness every Tuesday and Thursday for an hour.

Soon, Saturday will be added to the training days as well.

She does not have one regular trainer, but most the time it is Sam Vernon, the owner. The trainer shows her and others there what to do and what parts of the body it affects.

Despite her training, she has not fought yet because it is a challenge learning and remembering all 16 of the submissions. So far she only remembers six. But she plans to practice every chance she gets in case put in a situation where defense is needed.

For now, Kunkler is just training and cage-fighting

for fun, but she is looking to further her career in that. However with cagefighting comes some challenges.

She has had three surgeries on her knees caused by dislocations. She now has a screw in one of her knees and the other could dislocate at any second.

"It affects my fighting a lot, but it won't hold me back," she said.

Kunkler's mom is very supportive of her training and going into cage fighting.

"My mom goes to all my brother's fights and will soon be going to mine," she explained.

Also, her dad is supportive as well and friends of her think it is cool but do not want to try it.

So for those who say girls can't fight, "Or you fight like a girl," might be swallowing those words someday.
